- *Andropogon gerardii* (big bluestem)
- *Arctium minus* (common burdock)
- *Artemisia campestris* (western sagewort)
- *Artemisia dracunculus* (silky wormwood)
- *Carex austrina* (southern sedge)
- *Chenopodium ambrosoides* (Mexican tea)
- *Cyperus bipartitus* (slender flatsedge)
- *Cyperus esculentus* (yellow nutsedge)
- *Eleocharis erythropoda* (bald spikerush)
- *Eleocharis obtuse* (blunt spikerush)
- *Eragrostis trichodes* (sand lovegrass)
- *Hypericum majus* (greater St. Johnswort)
- *Juncus marginatus* (grassleaf rush)
- *Liatrus punctata* (dotted gayfeather)
- *Lomatium orientale* (biscuitroot)
- *Ludwigia alternifolia* (bushy seedbox)
- *Myriophyllum aquaticum* (parrotfeather watermilfoil)
- *Packera plattensis* (prairie ragwort)
- *Pellaea atropurpurea* (purplestem cliffbrake)
- *Penthorum sedoides* (ditch stonecrop)
- *Plantago virginica* (paleseeded plantain)
- *Rudbeckia hirta* (blackeyed susan)
- *Salix amygdaloides* (peachleaf willow)
- *Schizachyrium scoparium* (little bluestem)
- *Scrophularia lanceolata* (lanceleaf figwort)
- *Senna marilandica* (Maryland senna)
