Join us at the Wilson County Courthouse basement, 615 Madison, Fredonia, for a cup of coffee and home baked pastries. Following a few intros & instructions for the day, buses will transport participants to the wildflower site.



Leaders will be available to assist with plant ids share historical interpretations of the area, and give explanations of the ecological and historical significance of the site. More experienced enthusiasts may opt for a self-guided tour.

Be prepared for the day by wearing comfortable outdoor clothing and footwear suitable for uneven ground. A hat, insect repellent and sunscreen are recommended. Bring your camera to capture the smiles of the prairie.
